### ☐ *Read the Word*

Isaiah 54:5 (amp) – For your Maker is your Husband - the Lord of hosts is His name - God of the whole earth He is called.

### ☐ *Study and Reflect*

- Find the following scriptures to add to your Isaiah 54 notebook/journal.
  - His faithfulness is bound in his covenant of intimate marriage to us: Jeremiah 3:14
  - He has pledged to redeem us : Hosea 2:19
  - He is not just the God of the Jews, but the Gentiles, also: Roman 3:29
  - His name alone qualifies him as able to make these promises: Luke 1:32, Zechariah 4:19, Hebrews 11:6
  - Faith in God and His ability to rescue, redeem, and restore, has to come with knowledge of His Word: Romans 10:17, Hebrews 11:1

### ➤ *Word Study:*

Look up the following words and add them to your notebook/journal: Covenant, Redeemer, Lord of Hosts, Holy One, Husband/Marriage, intimacy,

□ *Answer the heart questions*

- ❏ What is the context of this verse?
  - What is being declared?
  - Who is it talking about?
  - What is the significance of the marriage covenant?
    - How can this be applied to your life?

*The KEY to this verse lies in our ability to fully understand the covenant God is making with us as His own. Our Maker is our husband; the Lord of Hosts is HIS Name. We are redeemed by the Holy One of Israel, also known as the God of the whole earth.*

- How can you restore relationships in your own life whether married or single by understanding the redemptive power of your covenant relationship with God?

Hosea 2:19 reveals the extent of this marriage contract between the God of the whole earth, the Holy One of Israel, and those who are bound to him by this covenant of love. "And I will betroth thee unto me FOREVER; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness and in judgment and in mercy."

We can see here that we are trusting on the power of HIS Name which is mighty to save and redeem, it will last for all generations, and on the fullness of his promise or oath which is unbreakable. His name, applied to us in the marriage ceremony, goes before us in righteousness, judgment, and mercy

- How often is his mercy revealed to us? Look up Lamentations 3:23
- How are we to walk in this relationship with Him? Look up Micah 6:8

❏ Write out the truth

- Copy the verse, meditate on the wisdom inherent within, and commit it to memory.

❏ Find the Truth for your situation.

- What changes need to be made in your life for you to see Him as your husband, maker, and redeemer?

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 reminds us that we need to cast down those high things, in our lives, that exalt themselves against the knowledge of Truth revealed to our hearts. (John 14:16 reminds us WHO Truth is.)

Ephesians 6:10-18 tells us to put on the whole armor of God that we may be able to stand strong in the face of adversity. We not only need to put on the Armor of God but clothe ourselves in the identity of the Holy One of Israel, our Maker and Husband-Redeemer by taking His Name as our own.

*Do a quick study on the power of HIS name and the authority we have to use it. Here are a few places you can start to look for scriptures: 1 John 5:13; Acts 2 and 3, Hebrews 1:3,4; Philippians 2:9,10; Ephesians 1:21, John 14 and 16.*

☞ Pray the truth

- Spend some time in quiet reflection of the revelation you have found through your study asking the Lord to begin to open up your eyes to the beauty of this marriage that He offers to us in His effort to redeem us through the intimate relationship of the role of Husband. Rest in the beauty of His glorious love for you, He is deeply in love with you, dear woman of God. You are loved and spend time this week just resting in that truth. Let your heart be healed and made whole in the promises of redemption and let your prayers be the petitions of a young bride to her bridegroom asking for grace, mercy, and guidance on how to please Him as you walk hand in hand into the covenantal marriage relationship that is both eternal and irrevocable in the eyes of our faithful God.

Each time we rest in your Word we find more and more of your precious grace abundantly offered to us. Thank you for each and every opportunity that you provide to know you more deeply and intimately.
