

## Restored to Receive an Inheritance

---

Lesson Day (Saturday): Read the Blog Post for that week that teaches the concept we are learning and the tool we are learning to use. Read through the entire chapter of Isaiah 54, and then focus on reading, copying, meditating and memorizing the verse for that week. During your journal time, add any additional scriptures that have encouraged you or deepened your study.

- ❑ *Read the Word*
- ❑ But no weapon that is formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall show to be in the wrong. This [peace, righteousness, security, triumph over oppression] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord [those in whom the ideal Servant of the Lord is reproduced]; this is the righteousness or the vindication which they obtain from Me [this is that which I impart to them as their justification], says the Lord. - Isaiah 54:17 (Amplified Version)

Read Romans 8:33-39:

*Who shall bring any charge against God's elect [when it is God who justifies [that is, Who puts us in right relation to Himself? Who shall come forward and accuse or impeach those whom God has chosen? Will God, Who acquits us?]] Who is there to condemn [us]? Will Christ Jesus (the Messiah), Who died, or rather Who was raised from the dead, Who is at the right hand of God actually pleading as*

*He intercedes for us? Who shall ever separate us from Christ's love? Shall suffering and affliction and tribulation? Or calamity, and distress? Or persecution, or hunger, or destitution, or peril, or sword? Even as it is written, For Thy sake we are put to death all the day long: we are regarded and counted as sheep for the slaughter. Yet amid all these things we are more than conquerors and gain a surpassing victory through Him Who loved us. For I am persuaded beyond doubt that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities, nor things, impeding and threatening nor things to come, nor powers, Nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

#### ☐ *Study and Reflect*

- Find the following scriptures to add to your Isaiah 54 notebook/journal.
  - The Lord is our portion and our inheritance is based on the allotment He gives, no one else decides our value or our gift. – Lamentations 3:24, Numbers 18:20, Psalm 16:5
  - When we are persecuted He is not only our defender, but our security and He is our judge. – Isaiah 41:17, Romans 8:33
  - Our security and final victory is our heritage, that which we inherit from Christ, He is our contender. – Jude 1:5, Isaiah 49:25
  - Though we are pressed down and shaken and the enemy attacks to destroy, we are established in Christ to not only survive but thrive. – Luke 6:38, Genesis 50:20, 2 Thessalonians 3:3, Psalm 54:7
- Word Study:  
Look up the following words and add them to your notebook/journal: Inheritance, Heritage, Faith, Prosperity, Contend/Contender, Portion

#### ☐ *Answer the heart questions*

- ☒ What is the context of this final verse in Isaiah 54?
  - Who are the servants of the Lord?
  - What is their reward?

- This concluding verse secures the idea of Restoration.
  - What are the key words used to describe the inheritance that faith in God assures?
  - How has God restored you?
    - Make a list of the ways that He has restored you in the past.
    - Now make a list of the ways that you have been restored to wisdom through this time of study and reflection.
    - Finally, make a list of the areas you long to see restored and write them in your prayer journal.

✎ Write out the truth

- Copy the verses, including any others that spoke to you this week, into your journal. Take time to meditate on them this week and try to commit them to memory.
- *Memorization Challenge: Take time to commit Romans 8:33-38 to memory.*

✎ Find the Truth for your situation.

- What are the rewards of a restored relationship with God listed in His Word?
- Where have you seen an example of this elsewhere in the Bible?
- Using the list that you made regarding restoration, find the promises in his Word to petition the Lord in prayer. This week, especially, spend time writing out your heart in prayer to the Lord and reveal the words that you heart longs to prepare as your own personal request. Then give them to Him, as a faith offering, remembering that His hope and purpose is to fill you with HIM as your portion. Trust that He will hold those needs gently and faithfully, changing you as He fills you with more of him and revealing more and more of His vision of restoration in and through you.

***Use your Prayer Journals this week write the unspoken prayers that your heart has been holding tightly. Release each word as a sacrificial seed of hope, trusting in the soil of your standing In Christ and the power of His Spirit raining upon the ground where you lay your burdens and pick up Hope.***
